

VENDOR FAQ'S – OMAF#2022

Q: Are Tents and Tables provided?

A: Tent is included in your vendor fee. Tables and chairs are NOT provided.

Q: What can we sell at OMAF?

A: The only restrictions are:

- No alcoholic beverages
- Drinks should not be sold in glass bottles.

Many vendors serve full meals; others serve beverages (smoothies, tea, health drinks, etc.) or snacks (e.g. popcorn).

Q: How much will we sell?

A: Your sales will depend on many factors, including your booth beautification efforts and quality of your food. However, in 2018 & 2019 individual food vendors reported total sales ranging between \$800 - \$5,000.00.

Q: What is included in my vendor fee?

A: Festival provides each vendor with a 10x10 tent

Q: What about cooking?

A: If you plan to cook food - whether with gas, electricity, or charcoal - you must follow the Fire Marshall's safety rules. The Fire Marshall will be inspecting each food vendor in the morning, and will close down any vendor not complying with their safety standards. Typical problems include not having the correct fire extinguisher, having frayed or worn flexible gas lines, or not having an electrical permit for generator.

Q: Is electricity available?

A: Unfortunately at this time the festival organizers do not supply vendors with electricity. Vendors are welcome to bring generators for cooking however it will be vendor's responsibility for complying with Fire Marshal rules/regulations and obtaining the necessary permits.

Q: Does the OMAF give exclusivity to Vendors?

A: At this time OMAF does not offer exclusivity however we do limit the amount of a particular product sold. If you're in need of exclusivity, contact our office via email at overtownmusicartsfestival@gmail.com

Q: Is there vehicle access to the booth?

A: vehicle access is NOT available. Only for food trucks and vendors who have paid for trailer space. We highly recommend you bring portable carts/dollies to transport your items.

Q: Where do Vendors park?

A: Vendor parking located with all other festival parking in the Lyric Theater parking lot

Q: Can I choose my location in the market?

A: No! Vendors locations are pre-assigned by festival coordinators. Request for specific location can be made however, your request is not guaranteed.

Q: What if it rains?

A: The festival will continue rain or shine. As we all know, weather in South Florida can be unpredictable. It is the responsibility of the Vendor to monitor the weather and to come properly prepared to withstand any weather conditions throughout the course of the Event. It is recommended that you bring tarps to cover any products/items that you may not want damaged by inclement weather, as well as ample supplies to dry tables, chairs, or any other items within your tent.
